

Emblem Club Scholarship Application Rules

Emblem Club scholarships are awarded to high school graduates or to students* currently enrolled in higher education to assist them in obtaining advanced education in their chosen field of study. (*12 credits per semester)

1. Each applicant must be submitted by the Emblem Club in which the member parent or grandparent of the applicant (member, son, daughter, step-child, step-grandchild, great grandchild, or step-great grandchild) is a current member in good standing.
2. Scholarship Award money must be used for tuition and any other educational expenses, or it must be refunded to the Emblem Club. It may also be used for the expense of a campus parking permit.
3. An applicant may receive no more than two (2) WIIM State Scholarship Awards and can submit only one (1) application for a WIIM State Association Scholarship Award during a fiscal year.
4. The completed application must be received by our Emblem Club, at **the address provided below.**

Directions for Emblem Scholarship Application

1. Create a typed one page resume of your academic, extra-curricular, civil affiliations, and leadership roles.
Your document should include:
 - Academic achievements including academic standing.
 - Scholastic, leadership, extra-curricular (sports & clubs), and civil honors and awards you have received.
 - Membership and affiliations in organizations and clubs, including academic, extra-curricular, religious, and civil organizations. A brief explanation of the mission statement for each organization and club.
 - Leadership experience in organizations and clubs, including academic, extra-curricular, religious, and civic organizations. Highlight the duties that you managed.
2. Provide an **official transcript** of 4 years of high school, signed by a school authority. The transcript must include ACT, SAT, or College Entrance Board Test scores/results. If a college student, the complete college transcript should be submitted in addition to the high school transcript, ACT, SAT scores.
3. Provide letters of recommendation from **two** people (i.e., pastor or prominent citizen) not connected with the school and not a relative. The letter should contain personal knowledge of the applicant pertaining to character, ability, integrity, etc. **The letter should be sent directly to the scholarship committee at the address listed below.**
4. Provide 2 letters from teaching staff stating qualifications observed and extracurricular activities, etc.
5. Applicant will submit a printed, double spaced personal statement highlighting the accomplishments outlined in the resume. Include reasons for why they deserve this scholarship and the need for financial assistance. Personal statement must be signed by the applicant. (not less than 100 words, not to exceed 200 words).
6. Provide a wallet-size picture (head and shoulders).
7. Show proof of acceptance or entrance to the institution and or enrollment in your current institution.

Complete and mail the documents to the Scholarship Committee by **February 26, 2018.**

Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.
