

ACTIVITY PACKAGE RULES AND REGULATIONS LINCOLN ELKS LODGE #914

1. Elk members of Lincoln Elks Lodge #914 may play golf, tennis, or swim only by purchasing an Activity Package. The only exception is golf on Logan County Mondays or with a punch card.
2. An Activity Package is sold for the full year of play only. **New Elk members joining after July 1st may purchase a ½ year membership.**
3. Current Activity Package members shall petition the Executive Committee for Medical exceptions.
4. All Elk members, eligible Elk family members, and guests must conduct themselves in the manner established by the Laws of the Elks.
5. The Club must not be used as a babysitting facility. It should be used as a benevolent youth activity.
6. No solicitation of services or merchandise that is provided by the Golf Professional will be allowed on Elk's property.
7. All buildings on Elks' property are NON-SMOKING.
8. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES TO BE BROUGHT ON ELKS PROPERTY.

FAMILY ACTIVITY MEMBERSHIP

1. A Family Activity Membership entitles the member, spouse, and eligible children to use the facilities of the package purchased. (i.e., Golf, Pool or Tennis)
2. Children are defined as: less than 24 years of age, unmarried, and living at home; or full-time students and servicemen or servicewomen home on leave.
3. A family membership also applies to a couple that is living together at the same residence. Both individuals **MUST** be current Elk's members.
4. Relatives, other than spouse and eligible children, cannot play on a Family Activity Package even though they live in the same home. May petition during special circumstances.
5. If a current Elk member's marital status changes after 4/1 of any year, the following rules apply:
 - a. Divorce: If the spouses are divorcing but a family activity package was purchased, the non-Elk member must join as an Elk to finish out the year under the family activity package.

- b. Marriage: If a member is getting married after 4/1 but a single membership was purchased, the couple may finish out the year under the member's single membership

GOLF

WHO MAY PLAY

1. Any Non-Elk or Elk who resides outside Lodge #914 jurisdiction may play golf upon payment of appropriate green fees.
2. Non-Elks living in the jurisdiction of Lodge #914 are NOT permitted to play golf on the Lincoln Elk's course except for Logan County Mondays or with a 2024-2025 punch card.
3. Prospective members will be allowed to play golf ONE time per year, and only as a guest of an Elk member. No other Elk member may bring the same guest again, excluding outings and Logan County Mondays.
4. Visiting grandchildren outside of #914 jurisdiction of a full package member may play golf at no charge if they are under the age of 12 and are accompanied by a grandparent. Grandchildren over the age of 12 years and under the age of 18 years must pay ½ price green fees.
5. Children who are between 12 and 18 years of age may play golf without an adult Monday-Friday and after 2 pm Saturday, Sunday, and holidays. Groups of any more than 3 at the discretion of the General Manager.
6. Children under the age of 12 years are not allowed on the golf course without parental supervision.
7. Parents are responsible for seeing that their children are familiar with the rules and etiquette of golf.

RESERVED GOLF PLAY

1. Men's league: Tuesday evenings (course closed at 5:30 P.M.)
2. Women's league: Wednesday morning (reserved tee times from 8:30-9:30 A.M.)

GOLF COURSE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Golf Shop is open every day from 7:00 AM until sundown. Opening times vary depending upon time of year.
2. ALL PLAYERS MUST REGISTER AT THE PRO SHOP, INDIVIDUALLY, BEFORE PLAYING.
3. All Players must start from the #1 tee. The Golf Shop Staff must approve starting at #10 tee. Continuing groups from #1 tee have priority of play.
4. Tee times are MANDATORY from 7:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.
5. Attire: Shirts must be worn at all times. Men's tank tops and sleeveless shirts are not allowed. Swim trunks and basketball shorts are not allowed.
6. Only soft spike shoes may be worn on the golf course.
7. Any group larger than 5 is at the discretion of the General Manager.
8. Slower players must allow faster groups following them to play through.
9. Each player must have a set of golf clubs and a bag.
10. No practicing on fairways or greens. Use practice area only.
11. A player is allowed to play only one golf ball at a time when playing 9 or 18 holes. NO EXCEPTIONS.
12. Driving Range: The Driving Range is for use of members, guests, and the general public on Logan Country Mondays. Range balls are not to be picked up or removed from the driving range.

GOLF CART POLICY

This Private Golf Cart Policy shall govern the use of all privately owned, personal golf carts, operated on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All private golf cart owners shall follow all rules and regulations outlined in the Activity Package Rules and Regulations and pay all applicable trail and greens fees.

2. All private golf cart owners shall obey all posted signs and warnings posted on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914.
3. All private golf cart owners shall be responsible for carrying their own liability insurance and any other insurance as required by law.
4. Any member who pays a private golf cart fee shall be permitted to drive any other privately owned golf cart with the permission of the private golf cart owner. Any person required to purchase his or her own Activity Package shall be required to pay a private golf cart fee to drive a private golf cart.
5. No private golf cart owner shall allow anyone without a valid Driver's License to operate a private golf cart on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914. A family member, as defined by the Activity Package, with a Driver's License Permit shall be allowed to operate a private golf cart while accompanied by the private golf cart owner.
6. No private golf cart shall carry more than two (2) riders at any time while operated on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914.
7. All privately owned golf carts shall display the golf cart decal as further outlined below.
8. Any violation of these rules and regulations will subject the private golf cart owner to the penalties as outlined below.
9. Annual Lease of Elks cart: Single or Double. Single lease is for one seat on the cart, if there is another rider, appropriate fees must be paid. Members with single cart leases are required to pair up and ride 2 per cart. Double lease members must belong under the same Activity Package.

DECALS

All private golf carts operated on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914 shall display, in some manner, a decal provided by the Lincoln Elks #914. A decal shall be provided to each private cart owner upon payment of the required private golf cart fee as provided in the Activity Membership Application. No private golf cart shall be operated on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914 without the above-mentioned decal and any golf cart without the decal will be removed from the premises.

PRIVATE CART STALLS

All private golf carts stored on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914 shall be assigned a stall number from the office. There is a one-time fee that is non-refundable. There is also an annual storage fee.

Nothing other than golf carts and golf equipment shall be stored in the Private Cart Stalls on the property of the Lincoln Elks #914.

A Work Order shall be completed to request maintenance of the sheds. These Work Orders are available in the Pro Shop and once filled out, should be returned to the Pro Shop.

PENALTIES*

Any violation of this Private Golf Cart Policy shall result in the following penalties:

First Violation—The first violation of the Private Golf Cart Policy, during the Activity Package Year, shall result in a maximum of a one (1) week suspension of all private golf cart privileges.

Second Violation—The second violation of the Private Golf Cart Policy, during the Activity Package Year, shall result in a maximum of a one (1) month suspension of all private golf cart privileges.

Third Violation—The third violation of the Private Golf Cart Policy, and any subsequent violation, during the Activity Package Year, could result in a suspension of private golf cart privileges for the remainder of the Activity Package Year.

*Failure to abide by the terms of a properly noticed penalty shall constitute a subsequent violation of this policy.

POOL AND COURTS

WHO MAY USE

1. Any Non-Elk or Elk who resides outside Lodge #914 jurisdiction may use the pool or tennis courts upon payment of the appropriate fees.
2. Non-Elks living in the jurisdiction of Lodge #914 are NOT permitted to use the pool or tennis courts on the Lincoln Elk's property.
3. Prospective members will be allowed to use the pool or tennis courts ONE time per year, and only as a guest of an Elk member. No other Elk member may bring the same guest again.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All Pool Members must have a picture I.D.

1. Adult swim is from 11:00 A.M. to 12:00 noon.
2. Proper attire required and shirts must be worn at all times while at the courts.
3. EVERYONE must register at the front gate when entering and show his or her picture I.D.
4. All guests must be accompanied by an activity package member and pay a guest fee of \$4.00. Guests that reside within the jurisdiction of Lodge #914 may only come once during the swim season.
5. Children 12 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent or a baby-sitter. Baby-sitters must be at least 16 years old.
6. Patrons with open sores or infectious skin diseases will not be permitted on lower deck.
7. No smoking on lower deck.
8. No running or horseplay on deck.

9. Absolutely no diving.
10. Management must approve baby-sitters under the age of 16.
11. Non-member baby-sitters need to be registered in the Elks office.
12. No fighting, rough play, or dunking in the pool.
13. No eating, chewing gum, or drinking in the pool.
14. No spitting, spouting of water or blowing of nose in water.
15. All trash must be thrown away.
16. A 15-minute adult swim will be called daily at 2:30 p.m.
17. Any activity, which deprives other members of full use and enjoyment of the pool facility, will not be tolerated.
18. Grandchildren 18 years of age and under may use the pool at no charge and must be accompanied by a grandparent.

GENERAL MANAGER AND GOLF SUPERINTENDENT NOTES

1. Please repair ball marks on the greens.
2. Please replace all visible divots or fill with sand.
3. Please rake bunkers.
4. Please keep all golf carts 30 Feet from tees & greens or on cart path.
5. Please pair-up on carts, when possible, to avoid undue stress to the turf.
6. Course Superintendent and General Manager are authorized to determine when the golf course is unfit for play or the use of golf carts due to weather conditions or course maintenance program.
7. Lost balls in native grass, “no mow areas,” play as a Red Penalty Area.
8. Respect other golfers and maintain the proper pace of play.

REPORTING VIOLATIONS

Any member of the Lincoln Elks #914, in good standing, may report violations of these Policies.

All violations shall be reported, in writing, to the Lincoln Elks Executive Committee. This form is available in the office. All reported violations should include a brief description of the incident, date of the incident, and enough information to allow the Executive Committee to determine who may have violated the Policy. All reported violations must be signed by the reporter and no anonymous reports will be considered by the Executive Committee.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

After consideration of a reported violation, the Lincoln Elks Executive Committee shall notify the Activity Package member, in writing, of the reported violation and any penalty associated with the violation. Said notification shall include the alleged date of the violation, a description of the violation, and a date upon which the penalty shall take effect. No penalty shall take effect until after the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Executive Committee.

APPEALS

All Activity Package members shall have the right to appeal the decision of the Executive Committee at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Executive Committee. If the Activity Package member fails to appear at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Executive Committee, the right to appeal the decision of the Executive Committee shall be waived.
